Funding Success



Arnside Sailing Club has come second in Sunsail Funding for the Future Contest winning £2000 towards the cost of a new Hartley 12.2. Sunsail are a holiday company offering sailing holidays worldwide https://www.sunsail.co.uk/



We have received £4725 funding from Cumbria Community Foundation (Dulverton Fund and Cumbria Grassroots Fund) towards the cost of a Topaz 14 catamaran, which is a bigger version of the Topaz 12 children's catamaran we already have. The boat is suitable for older teenagers and light weight adults.

Ziska From Arnside to Alaska



Ziska, a 116 year old yacht built by Crossfields of Arnside in 1903 took part in the Race to Alaska taking 16 days to complete the 750 mile race.

The Race to Alaska runs from Port Townsend on the West Coast of America to Ketchikan in Alaska. It is designed to show case the latest technology for human and wind powered boats.

Whilst Ziska was a long way behind the winners Team Angry Beavers, who completed the race in 4 days 4 hours in their modern light weight high performance boat, Ziska was 22nd overall out of 35 starters. Ziska coped better with gales than her modern light weight competitors. However when the wind dropped, Ziska's crew including at the finish line had to row her 15 tonnes.

We are planning to hold a mini exhibition in the Clubhouse at August Bank Holiday weekend to celebrate her achievement.

Club Boats

Depending on their experience and whether they being used for training club boats are available for use by members free of charge.

We now have the following boats at Arnside

1 Laser - A single handed dinghy suitable for adults and older teenagers.

1 Wayfarer - A stable family dinghy used extensively for training with room for up to 6 people.

1 Wanderer - One of the most stable dinghies on the market. It has room for 4 people. Being lighter than a Wayfarer it is easier to launch.

6 Hartley 10 - A small stable boat used by small children with two in the boat or single handed by older children. It can also be sailed by teenagers and small to medium sized adults. The boats are ten feet long.

3 Hartley 12.2 - A doubled handed boat for teenagers and adults with asymmetric spinnakers. The boats are twelve long and can also be sailed single handed with one sail up.

1 Topaz 12 – a twelve foot long child's catamaran
