





Hire the Sailing Club for your party or meeting

The clubhouse overlooks the estuary and is a great venue for parties and meetings. Facilities include bar, kitchen, sound equipment, screen, projector and an outdoor seating and garden area

Cost

£125 including staffed bar (Members £62.50), for half a day (eg evening, lunchtime or afternoon) plus £100 returnable deposit against damages. For non members the fee includes temporary membership of the club for the duration of the event. If you access to the building all day (eg to set up in the morning for an evening event), the price is £200 (members £100)

Venue capacity

The clubhouse will comfortably seat 50 people. Extra seats and tables are available Capacity for music and party nights is 70 people.

Cut off time for music/event

All functions must finish by 12.00pm and the clubhouse cleared by 1.00am. Persons leaving the premises must be considerate of the sailing club's neighbours.

Licensing Rules

Normal licencing rules apply to all private functions

- 1) It is against the law for anybody under the age of 18
 - To buy alcohol
 - To have an adult to buy alcohol for them
 - To drink alcohol in a licensed premises

(However 16 or 17 olds accompanied by an adult, can drink (but not buy) beer, wine or cider with a meal) The club may ask for proof of age for anybody who looks under 25.

- 2) It is illegal to sell alcohol after a premise's permitted licensing hours
- 3) It is illegal to sell or buy alcohol for someone who is drunk and for the club to allow disorderly conduct in its premises. If asked to leave if is an offence for a disorderly person to refuse to leave,

ASC Clubhouse Disabled Access

There are 12 steps up from the street level into the clubhouse bar/music venue.

For visitors who are unable to walk up or down the steps, there is access to the rear of the building, which can be used to access the bar/music venue. The access is uneven and would probably require assistance.

There is a ramp at the rear door and the bar/music venue is flat. Wheelchair users will need assistance using the ramp.

The toilets in the clubhouse are on a level with the bar/music venue, but are standard door width, limiting wheelchair access. There is no disabled toilet facility within the club.

Vehicle access can be gained by driving up Church Hill (behind the Albion pub) and down the unmade lane on the left, at the corner of Church Hill back down toward the promenade. A car can then stop to give access to the rear gates at the side of the club house. The car can't remain there, as access is required, but can be driven down the track and on to the promenade.

Please be aware that some clubhouse events are standing or have limited unreserved seating.

Getting to our Clubhouse

The Clubhouse is located on Arnside Promenade between the Fighting Cocks and Albion.

There is parking on the Promenade. Arnside is on the railway line from Manchester and Lancaster to Barrow. Bicycles can be parked in the garden by prior arrangement. The Club House is within walking distance of much of the village. Taxis need to be booked in advance.
